During the past National Meetings several delegates commented how their local Chapters conduct their local tournaments.

Examples are allowing their members to tee off from the forward tee markers.

Question: What yardage are the forward tee markers?

Another example was allowing their members to tee off from the white tee markers.

Question: What yardage are the white tee markers on your golf course? 6200, 6400, 5900.

Question: What is the average yardage, tournament chairmen's use for local golfing events?

The Missouri City Chapter tee markers during local tournaments are approximately 6500 yards or less. All members tee off from the same tee markers, except the ladies.

During the National Tournaments, what yardage is use for different flights?

Per the information on the National PAGA website, the following information is available.

During the National Tournament in Houston 2012, each golf course or flight had an assigned yardage.

Attachment title,"2012 National Tournament hosted by Houston Tee Markers", is included on this proposal.

Purpose: To establish Standard yardages with allowances for National Tournaments and Local Golf Tournaments.

Golf Course A thru D	Standard Tees	Ladies Flight

The host city will attempted to follow the standard yardages.

Note: It is a possibility that the flights may change depending on participation.

Example: Golf Course "A" could have 3 flights. Championship,  $1^{st}$  &  $2^{nd}$  flight. Everyone on Golf Course "A" would tee off from the same tee markers because they are also competing in the National Seniors Tournament.

Ladies Flight: They will compete from the Standard Ladies Tees.
