When it comes to area attractions, Harlingen has something for everyone! For **Nature Enthusiasts** there is the World Birding Center and two of the most unique wildlife refuges in the country. Harlingen is also home to Bass Pro Shops, a popular tourist destination. eateries. Specialties include tex-mex, barbecue, juicy burgers, and fresh salads and sandwiches. A vintage vinyl shop, old-fashioned soda bar, and authentic army surplus store are just a few of the reasons that locals and visitors alike flock to the area.

Downtown Harlingen hosts the Harlingen Farmer's Market and Jackson Street Market Days in addition to family movie nights, parades,

classic car shows, and other popular community events. While you are here, take in a tour of the historic downtown business district or Harlingen's larger-than-life murals. There is always ample free parking.



lwo Jima Memorial Monument

This stunning outdoor sculpture is the original from which the monument in Arlington, Virginia was cast and depicts the raising of the US flag over Iwo Jima on Feb. 23, 1945, during World War II. It is over 100 feet high and weighs 130 tons. Across the street is the museum and gift shop. The museum features Marine Corps Memorabilia, a video about the battle, and a veteran's hall of fame.
