Greetings Fellow Members,

Seven months ago, we began using the newly created StarterShack application. It was a very basic program at its infancy. Through the input and suggestions from the PAGA members, George Riley has developed a program that meets our needs.

At the release of the program, we the contacts for StarterShack received many phone calls asking for help. I seldom get a phone call or email asking for help now. Our membership learned to use it in a very short time. It is a very user-friendly program and George is striving to make it even better. I have received many reports from Chapter Tournament Directors and Club Administrators commenting on the ease of using StarterShack.

Better than 90% of our chapters are using the tournament function StarterShack offers. Two chapters still prefer to use their own system, which they used prior to StarterShack and Handicomp. Not using the tournament application means they are having to do to double the work; they must record the scores manually into StarterShack after they run the tournament on their system. Visiting members from other chapters playing a tournament where the chapter don't use StarterShack have to take the scorecard to their tournament director to have their score recorded.

I applaud you my fellow members for being so eager to learn the StarterShack system. Doing so helps unify our organization and progress forward to having a level playing field for all our members. I implore each chapter to share the knowledge gained in StarterShack with fellow members. This will help ensure your next tournament director can step in without any issues running tournaments for your chapter.

NATIONAL VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Welcome to our 2018 National PAGA Convention & Tournament...!

I want to thank all the Corpus Christi chapter members, their officers, local sponsors, and everyone that has been instrumental in the success of this National Convention & Tournament. Their hard work, planning, and commitment has paid off, congratulations!

During my 2018 Odessa Winter Meeting Report, I announced that after careful consideration, we the board, had agreed to continue awarding National PAGA Scholarships with some donated funds (approx. \$2,000.00) that we have in reserve under our National PAGA Junior 501c3 organization. I also announced that these scholarships would not be paid from our national treasury since our National PAGA Scholarship program was eliminated by a delegate vote at our 2017 3rd National Delegates Meeting & Workshop in San Antonio. It was also announced by our national president that more scholarship funds would be raised by holding a Casino Fund Raising Night in Corpus Christi during the Parade of Colors night sponsored by Tito's Handmade Vodka. He also encouraged all chapters to voluntarily donate prizes if they could.

Several days after our 2018 Odessa National Winter Meeting, the board received a letter from Mr. Jesse Pena, Parliamentarian for said meeting, stating that our intent of awarding scholarships under the National Junior 501c3 organization was out of order. His letter stated that the national board can not conduct a National Junior 501c3 fundraiser for the purpose of scholarships without the NPAGA Junior 501c3 organization's approval. He stated that we could continue with the fund raiser through a specific chapter and have them donate such funds to the national PAGA Junior 501c3 organization. The Junior 501c3 organization will then hold these funds until a resolution can be agreed on how these funds will be used. After a conversation with the chairman of our NPAGA Junior 501c3 organization, Mr. Ramiro Romo, he further explained that the national PAGA board definitely cannot award any scholarships under the 501c3 organization since we are two completely separate entities. He stated that any scholarships that are awarded by the NPAGA Junior 501c3 organization will only apply to our PAGA chapters at the local level and not nationwide as was the custom of our National PAGA Scholarship Program.

Consequently, the Casino Fund Raiser Event will now serve strictly for the purpose of raising funds for the benefit of the NPAGA Junior 501c3 organization. These funds will be eligible to be used for future Junior Tournaments, Clinics, trophies, etc...

FYI, I received a total of twenty-eight (28) scholarship apps this year. Surprisingly four apps were from Florida, one from CT, one From GA and one from IL. The rest were from Texas.

As a reminder, I have included a copy of our National Convention & Winter Meeting Rotation List. Please review it and start planning accordingly as your chapter nears your turn in hosting the next upcoming national events. Please keep your chapter exposed to your local communities as we promote Junior, Senior, Ladies, and Men's Golf throughout Texas and the nation.
