National Convention Reports:

Post report 2021 NPAGA Winter Meeting, PAGA of New Braunfels, Mr. Sammy Martinez — a total of 225 golfers attended; two courses were used Plum Creek and Landa Park. Total profit reported was \$1,021.28

Post report 2021 National 3rd Delegates Meeting, PAGA of Killeen, Mr. Fernando Sanchez – a total of 70 golfers attended; all golfers golfed at Stone Tree GC. Total profit reported was \$578.83

2022 National Winter Meeting, PAGA of Brazoria County, Mr. Jim Luna – thank you delegates for attending the Winter Meeting. We would also like to thank all the chapters that bought a ad in the brochure. This weekend we have 98 golfers at The Wilderness and 96 at Freeport. All payout will be at the awards and dance at RiverPlace.

2022 National Convention & Tournament, PAGA of El Paso, Mr. Pete Solis and Mr. David Moore — the dates are set for July 25-July 29, 2022. The event will include a two-day golf tournament for juniors, women and men. Daily activities are scheduled for non-golfers. Paso Del Norte will serve as Headquarters for this event. El Paso will have a Parade of colors, dance and awards ceremony. Chuco Golf is a sponsor for Nationals and will offer 25% off to PAGA members.

2022 National 3rd Meeting & Workshop, PAGA of Irving, Mr. Pete Gomez and Mr. David Gutierrez – date has been set for October 7-8, 2022. The host hotel and delegates meeting will be at Wyndham DFW Airport Hotel in Irving, TX. The golf tournament will be at Bear Creek GC in Euless.

2023 National Winter Meeting & Tournament, PAGA of San Marcos, Ms. Melissa Castro – San Angelo has informed the NPAGA Board that they will not be able to host in 2023. The NPAGA President Mr. Aguillon has appointed the next chapter in line San Marcos to host in 2023. Dates and more information will follow.

2023 National Convention & Tournament, PAGA of San Antonio, Mr. Lalo Gamboa – dates are set for July 24-28, 2023. The headquarters hotel will be the Marriot San Antonio Airport. Golf courses reserved are The Quarry, Silverhorn, Olympia Hills, Brackenridge, Hyatt Hill Country, Mission Del Lago and Olmos GC.

2023 3rd Meeting & Workshop, NPAGA President Mr. Ray Aguillon Jr, Host city is still open; decision will be made at National Convention in El Paso. A rotation list is in the works for future 3rd Delegates Host Cities.

Motion was not made to suspend the NPAGA Delegates Meeting due no one from the NPAGA Junior Golf Corporation present

New Business:

Amendment to the NPAGA By-laws, PAGA of OKC, Mr. Robert Poor — The changes proposed by the Oklahoma chapter presented at the winter meeting address Article V of the constitution. The first proposal is an addition to SECTION 2. Section 2 requires a minimum of 3 National Business Meetings per year. As we have learned from the pandemic there will be events beyond our control that prevent the inperson assembly of the delegation. The proposed addition will allow the usage for Video Conferencing services to fulfill our national meeting requirements. Note the use of video conferencing does not replace the assembly of the delegation when conditions permit.

The second proposal updates SECTION 3. Section 3 allows for the National President to call a special meeting by notifying the delegates 30 days prior to the meeting. The proposed changes include the use of email in addition to 1st class mail for the notification process. Also, these special meetings would be conducted using video conferencing services.

Raffle report, NPAGA Secretary, Mr. Ernie Torres – a raffle was conducted as a fundraiser to help expenses of visiting out of state chapters. The drawing was on February 16th at approximately 5pm at the National Archives in San Antonio, TX by National President Mr. Ray Aguillon Jr. and National Secretary Ernie Torres. A total of \$1956 was spent on prizes leaving us with \$2144.

Old Business:

NPAGA Logo Patent/Trademark Update, National Secretary - Mr. Ernie Torres

The trademark application has been filed for "The National Pan American Golf Association PAGA" (and design) with the U.S Patent and Trademark Office, and it has been assigned serial number 97062915. In approximately 4 months, an assigned examining attorney will review the application to determine if all legal requirements are met. Currently the mark is not registered and is considered a "pending" application. The overall process from the time of initial filing to registration or final refusal can take 13-18 months or even longer, depending on many factors (e.g., the correctness of the original filing and the type of application filed.)

National NPAGA Committee Reports

NPAGA Men's Hall of Fame Committee, National VP - Mr. Rafael
Nanez II — a committee has been formed by Mr. Nanez that consists of
Hall of Famers - Andy Rivera (Houston), David Longoria (Corpus Christi),
Fred Salinas (Missouri City), Paul Moreno (Austin), Bobby Rodriguez
(San Marcos), Leo Cadena (Edinburg), and Toyo Amador (Seguin). The
HOF committee received 4 applications which none had qualifying
votes according to the guidelines.

For the first time in existence of the Men's Hall of Fame a ballot was sent in with a woman's name. The ballot was not counted due to the guidelines not accepting women's applications. The following guidelines will get reviewed at consolidating the Hall of Fame into one.

Mr. Fred Salinas brought up accusation that a woman is allowed. The women created a Women's Hall of Fame and since its inauguration year have set their own guidelines for women applicants.

Women's Hall of Fame Committee, PAGA of Brownsville – Dr. Olivia Rivas – the Women's HOF was established in 2006, its first inductee was in 2008. The HOF currently has seven women

National Joint Hall of Fame Committee, Mr. Rafael Nanez II & Dr. Olivia Rivas – will work to improve the guidelines and to initialize one Hall of Fame.

Women's Committee, PAGA of Corpus Christi – Ms. Cookie McBride Motion was made by Mr. Fred Salinas for NPAGA to donate \$1,000 to Women's Committee. Seconded by Ms. Cookie McBride Delegates voted majority for the approval

PAGA of Irving donated \$200; PAGA of Dallas donated \$100 to the Women's Committee



Subject: Proposed changes to the Constitution

Delegates,

Attached are two proposed changes to Article V, Meeting Procedures, of the National Constitution. The first proposal is an addition to SECTION 2. Section 2 requires a minimum of 3 National Business Meetings per year. As we have learned from the pandemic there will be events beyond our control that prevent the in-person assembly of the delegation. The proposed addition will allow the usage for Video Conferencing services to fulfill our national meeting requirements. Note the use of video conferencing does not replace the assembly of the delegation when conditions permit.

The second proposal updates SECTION 3. Section 3 allows for the National President to call a special meeting by notifying the delegates 30 days prior to the meeting. The proposed changes include the use of email in addition to 1st class mail for the notification process. Also, for these special meetings would be conducted using video conferencing services.

ARTICLE V. MEETING PROCEDURES

SECTION 2. A minimum of three (3) National Business Meetings must be held each year. No chapter shall host an invitational or special tournament during the National Tournament and Convention. Exceptions must be cleared by the National Board.

Add - In the event of unforeseen circumstances that prevent the in-person assembly of the board and delegation, video conferencing services will be used to fulfill the organization national meeting requirements.

If the majority of said delegates favor a meeting, the President shall, upon receiving said information, name a time and place of said meeting. If the delegates fail to respond, their failure to respond shall be taken as affirmative votes and the meeting shall take place.

The National President may call a special meeting by notifying the National Delegates by first class mail at least thirty (30) days prior to conducting said meeting. Delegates will be informed by email and or 1st class mail. Delegates shall respond within fifteen (15) days of the posting of said notice from the President. If the majority of said delegates favor a meeting, the President shall, upon receiving said information, name a time and date of said meeting. If the delegates fail to respond, their failure to respond shall be taken as affirmative votes and the meeting shall take place. Video conferencing services will be used to conduct said meeting.


