HALL OF FAME CHAIRMAN  
AND  
COMMITTEE GUIDELINES



DUTIES HALL OF FAME CHAIRMAN

1. Select six (6) Members to the Hall of Fame Committee.
  2. Conduct all Hall of Fame Committee meetings.
  3. Review and distribute the Hall of Fame applications.
- DUTIES SIX (6) HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE MEMBERS

1. The Hall of Fame Committee is charged with administrative responsibilities assisting the Hall of Fame Chairman with the initial review of the applications for completeness, eligibility, and verifying candidate information. The voting ballot package will be forwarded to the Voting Committee members for their vote. The Hall of Fame Committee will meet during the Winter Meeting to count the ballots received from the Voting Committee Members.
2. Hall of Fame Committee members agree not to be an applicant of the Hall of Fame during any year of service.
3. A roster of the Hall of Fame Committee members and all activities conducted by the Hall of Fame Committee will be submitted to the National Secretary for publication to the National membership.

VOTING COMMITTEE MEMBERS

1. Composed of NPAGA Hall of Fame Members both men and women and NPAGA members appointed by the Hall of Fame Chairman.
- a) Members may consist of National Officers from 1971 to present, Delegates or Members appointed by the Hall of Fame Chairman with a minimum of 20 years in the association.
- b) The Committee will maintain a minimum of 25 voting members at all times.
2. Hall of Fame Voting Committee members can be both men and women Hall of Fame Inductees and respected members with at least (20) years in the National Association

APPLICATIONS

1. Applications must be submitted and postmarked or emailed no later than January 31 of the year of induction.
2. Members may apply a total of 3 times. If not inducted after 3 tries, there will be a 3 year waiting period before resubmitting to the Hall of Fame.





3. Applications must contain a cover letter from the applicant, a formal letter of consideration from the respective Chapter signed by the local President and another Officer, biographical narrative on the candidate addressing how they meet the Hall of Fame credentials found on the worksheet and a photograph of the candidate.

4. Applications not in compliance with the requirements shall be returned to the respective chapter in a timely manner for possible correction and resubmission before January 31.

5. Applications must be typed up.

6. The inductee must have a minimum of twenty years (20) in the National Association.

#### VOTING RESULTS

1. Each applicant must receive 2/3 of eligible votes cast.

2. The Credentials worksheet point system will be the determining factor should there be more than two (2) candidates that receive 2/3 of the eligible votes casted.

#### ANNOUNCEMENT OF INDUCTEES

A formal announcement of inductees will be made at the National Winter Delegates Meeting of the current year. A formal announcement of inductees will be made 60 days before the National Tournament and Convention of the current year.

#### INDUCTEES PER YEAR

1. There will be a maximum of two (2) inductees per year.

#### HALL OF FAME CHAIRMAN EXPENSES

Plaques will be purchased by the National Association

The Chairman will receive room and traveling expenses approved by the National Treasury only when required reporting to the Board and Delegates is warranted.

#### CRITERIA

#### PURPOSE

The purpose of the National Pan American Golf Association Hall of Fame is to preserve the History of the organization and to recognize and honor men and women who have excelled in the game of golf and/or who have demonstrated loyalty, dedication and distinguished service for the advancement of our organization at the National and local level.

#### ELIGIBILITY

1. NPGA member active/non-active of twenty years or greater.
2. Minimum of 200 credential points are necessary to be considered for induction.

#### APPLICATIONS

Applications are to be supplemented with the following documents for consideration.

1. Formal written request from a respective chapter expressing consideration for induction signed by two local officers.

2. Hall of Fame Biography (Narrative).
3. Hall of Fame Candidate Information.
4. Hall of Fame Credentials.
5. Additional supporting documents if available.
6. Hall of Fame applications can ONLY be submitted by respective chapter.
7. Applications must be typed up.

#### APPLICATION DEADLINE

Submitted application with all the necessary documents to the Hall of Fame Chairman postmark or emailed by January 31 of the current year.

#### AWARD

A plaque to be presented to the inductee or family member at the awards ceremony on Friday of the national tournament and convention and a similar plaque will be on display at the Pan American National Archives.

Plaques will be purchased by the National Association

Hall of fame members will be recognized as a life time NPGA Members. StarterShack fees will be paid by the National Treasury
